Access to Higher Education Diplomas

Your first step towards your dream degree

Want to study a degree but don't yet have the entry qualifications?

For many people, achieving their dream career is not always a straightforward path and traditional qualifications don't fit everyone's journey to success.

That's where Access to Higher Education Diplomas come in: one-year courses designed to help adults gain the qualification they need to progress to university and into their dream career. Plus, it could even be **free**!*

What is an Access to Higher Education Diploma?

An Access to Higher Education Diploma is a nationally recognised Level 3 qualification that enables people without traditional qualifications to get into university.

How long does an Access to Higher Education Diploma take?

Access courses take just one year to complete and are offered as either a daytime or evening option. They are typically studied two days a week, from September to June.

Who are they for?

Access to Higher Education diplomas are perfect for adults aged 19 and over who want to:

- › Achieve the qualifications needed to progress to higher education
- › Change careers or explore a new field
- › Expand skills and knowledge for promotion or professional growth

Ready to start your journey? Take the first step towards your dream degree!

What is it equivalent to?

Access courses are equivalent to other Level 3 qualifications like A Levels. They are recognised by universities as an alternative to traditional academic qualifications.

Can I study for free?

Depending on your circumstances, your Access to Higher Education Diploma could be free:

- › If you're aged 19 to 23 and this is your first full Level 3 qualification
- › If you're aged 24+ and complete a degree after your course, your Advanced Learner Loan fees will be completely written off

Can you work while studying?

Access courses are designed to work around your commitments. Whether you're working, have family responsibilities, or need to balance study with a busy lifestyle, you can still gain the qualification you need to unlock new opportunities.

*Your Access course could be **free** – if you go on to complete a university-level course, your Advanced Learner Loan will be written off! Find out more on our website.

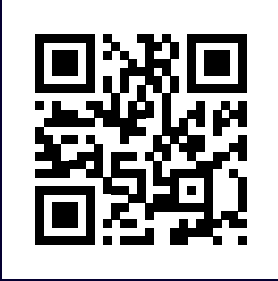

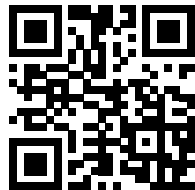

How to apply to UCM

Apply Direct

You can apply for a University Centre Middlesbrough course direct without going through UCAS. Applying direct is quick, easy and free!

Step 1: Head to our website via the QR code above and find the course you want to study.

Step 2: Click 'Apply Now' and complete the online application form.

Once your application is received, we'll arrange an informal chat for you and the course programme leader to discuss the course, answer any questions, assess course suitability and make an offer.

Apply through UCAS

If you would prefer, you can apply to our programmes via UCAS. If your application is successful, our team will formally offer you a place through UCAS and your programme leader may get in touch for an informal discussion.

To apply through UCAS, follow the below steps:

- › **Register your details:** If you're new to UCAS, create an account and fill in your personal information.
- › **Student Finance England:** If you've told UCAS you'll need help paying for your course, your information will be shared with Student Finance England who will process your application.
- › **Course selection:** You can apply for up to five higher education courses. You can find UCAS codes on each individual course on our website.
- › **Personal statement:** You will need to craft a personal statement to support your application. This is your opportunity to sell yourself and make your UCAS application stand out from the crowd. Tell us your future career ambitions and why you want to study your selected programme.
- › **References:** Ask a former tutor, advisor or professional to provide an academic reference that supports your application.
- › **Submit:** Submit your application with a £28.95 UCAS fee. Financial support may be available via Student Services depending on your circumstances.

Understanding UCAS tariff points



When applying for a university course, you'll see UCAS tariff points listed as part of the entry requirements. These points are a way to measure your predicted grades or qualifications and show whether you meet the entry criteria for a course.

Don't worry if you don't meet the exact points. Relevant industry experience or vocational training can also be considered. Contact our team to arrange an interview with the programme tutor, who will assess your suitability and help you explore your options.

Fees and finance

Your ambitions shouldn’t be limited by finance. Whatever your financial situation, there’s a range of financial support options available to help you fund your studies and focus on achieving your goals.

Tuition fee loans

Full and part-time students who are studying a qualification worth 30 credits or more can apply for a tuition fee loan through Student Finance England.

Repayment starts only when you’re earning over £25,000.

Your student loan won’t affect your credit rating or future borrowing.

Maintenance loans

If you are a full-time UK student, you can also apply for a maintenance loan to help with living costs such as accommodation, food and bills.

Employer sponsorship

Some employers may cover part or all of your tuition fees, especially if the course relates to your current role. This is a great way to develop your skills, boost work performance and advance your career.

Did you know?

By the age of 31, people with a degree usually earn about 33% more than those without a university qualification.*

Grants for disabled students

Eligible students can apply for the Disabled Students’ Allowance (DSA) via Student Finance England. The DSA can support students with:

- › Learning difficulties
- › Mental health conditions
- › Physical disabilities
- › Long-term health conditions

The allowance can be used for specialist equipment, non-medical helpers or travel costs. Applications open from February half-term and can take up to 14 weeks to process, so make sure to apply early!

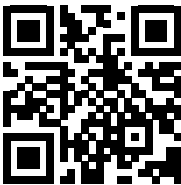
Changes to Courses
